Weekend Spiritual Direction Changes by Pastor John Foster

A Via de Cristo Weekend "is a Christian renewal effort, inspired by God that works faith and renewal within the Church" (taken from the 1st sentence of the SD Manual). The servants on this weekend are drawn from both lay and clergy across various faith walks. The clergy that accept the call to be Spiritual Directors need to be sensitive to the spiritual needs of both the team and candidates and follow the guidelines of national and local governing bodies, as well as the Rector/a.

Three years ago, we had several female clergy who were able to participate as Lead and General Spiritual Directors, but within a year the female Lead SD went through changes in her employment and could no longer serve as a Lead SD. A couple more female clergy went through changes in their physical health and had to withdraw from any participation. Although we were able to provide men to fill in those positions, many lay women in leadership kept asking for us to find more women clergy.

Your prayers are being answered! Pastor Mary Ashcraft has accepted our call to her to be a Lead Spiritual Director. She has extensive experience in Via de Cristo having made Weekend #3 and serving as a Rectora on Weekend #27. She will be a General SD on this coming Weekend #65 and will be available to be called as a Lead SD next Spring.

In addition to Mary, we are currently reviewing two other applications for Lead SD positions – one male and one female. We are also training new Spiritual Directors for future weekends as they become known to us. Our two newest SDs are Jan Foster and Dan Hummer. Jan made Weekend #14 and served as a Rectora on Weekend #36. She is currently a Licensed Pastor and is now in training to be an ordained Chaplain. Dan is a recent graduate from Weekend #64 and a retired VA Chaplain.

The other change of note concerning the weekends has to do with the Christian Life (Life in Grace) talk. That talk was one of the five "Grace" talks that the SDs gave on the weekend. However, a few years after Sonbeam began; it became difficult for a Spiritual Director to give that Sunday morning talk because all of our SDs, at that time, were pastors of churches. Now we have pastors, chaplains and retired clergy on the weekends, so there is always a pastor who is able to give that talk. Starting with the next set of weekends (#66), that talk will, once again, be given by clergy.

We need your help. There are 2,787 active and inactive cursillistas to draw from for weekend duty, but only 17 are clergy and 4 are qualified to be a Lead SD. Talk to your pastors and encourage them to make a weekend. The more pastors we have to draw from, the more rested our present group of clergy will be.

Heart of Reunion by Sue Neal

While there is no doubt that my VdC weekend was a mountain top experience, and I still cannot quite put to words all that it meant to me, for me, being a part of a reunion group is that much more.

We receive so much love and grace on our weekend, and we leave, at least most of do, I believe, so full and encouraged and uplifted, we are ready to tackle the world. The world, however, can quickly have other ideas for us, and discouragement and feeling let down can come pretty quickly. This is why I feel that reunion groups are so very important to the VdC movement and to our individual walks with Christ.

Having a reunion group means always being able to be yourself. Trusting your brothers or sisters will listen to you, without judgment, but at the same time encourage your walk in faith and growth in Christ. They will set you right when you need it, and hug and cry with you when you need that. Just knowing they are praying for you can be such an encouragement.

It is through these groups that we really become bonded with other believers, and with the VdC community. Those who do not become a part of a solid reunion group are the ones we rarely, if ever, hear from again. As sponsors, and as part of the wonderful VdC family, I believe we need to really encourage the babe chicks to form groups, starting at the tables on the weekend. Be praying how all of us can reach out in a more effective way to get the babe chicks involved? What can we do at closing or at the post Ultrix to encourage them to get in a Reunion Group? Several people have said they are willing to help get new groups started, by setting up starter groups in various areas and/or form one large group. Several of us are willing to help lead and draw them in to the love and support of the Reunion Group. What can you do to encourage them? 7
